This action brought the period of indecision to an end; the workers were in power and all who opposed them were stamped as counter-revolutionary; it brought an end to the compromise between the Mensheviki and the bourgeoisie under the guise of revolutionary unity, and showed these two factions in their true colors, i. e., antiworking class. After November 7th, the class division in Russia stood out clearly; all the workers and poor peasants supported the Bolsheviki, and the land-owners, the bourgeoisie and their hangers on were anti-Bolsheviki. Soon after gaining power the Bolshevik Government drafted two decrees; one dealt with the armistice on all fronts, the other with the abolition of private ownership of land. By this means they enlisted the support of the workers and peasants with their cry of Peace and Land. Ninety per cent of the workers in Russia were sick of war, and any Government which hoped for success was bound to strive for peace. The...
